

# BIBLIOGRAPHY

There is a sizeable literature on Jane Fonda and her family. To the extent that the literature contains material germane to the subject of this book — Fonda's activities in wartime North Vietnam — it is cited below.

The literature on America's involvement in Vietnam is vast, and we have drawn on it only to the extent necessary to address our subject. Since central to that subject is the condition of American prisoners in Vietnam and their exposure and reaction to Fonda's activities there, we have drawn substantially on personal memoirs, some of which are cited below along with other books addressing the same point.

The subject of treason in American legal literature has not been addressed nearly as much as it should have been. Because most of what exists on the subject is found in the eight reported judicial decisions discussed in Part III above, we have not provided a treason bibliography here.

The only Congressional material on Jane Fonda's July 1972 trip to North Vietnam consists of the Hearing Report of the House of Representatives Internal Security Committee, September 19, 1972, cited below.
